In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 34 of the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1960 (34 of 1960), the Government of Kerala, after having previously published the draft rules calling for objections and suggestions as per the notification No.LBRD-E3/103/2021/LBR. dated 15th December, 2021 and published in the Kerala Gazette



Extraordinary No.3711 dated 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 as required under sub-section (4) of section 34 of the said Act, hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Rules, 1961, namely:-

## RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments (Amendment) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of the Rules.- (1) In the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Rules, 1961,-

(i) rule 2E shall be omitted;

(ii) sub-rule (3) of rule 2G shall be omitted;

(iii) rule 12A shall be omitted;

(iv) Form H shall be omitted.

## **Explanatory Note**

purport.)

The Government of Kerala is taking active steps for minimizing regulatory compliance burden for citizen and industries to increase the Ease of Doing Business. As a part of promoting the e-governance, the Department of Labour had introduced online registration and renewal of establishment through Labour Commissionerate Automation System. Now, therefore, the Government have decided to make suitable amendments in the Kerala Shops and Commercial Establishments Rules, 1961.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
